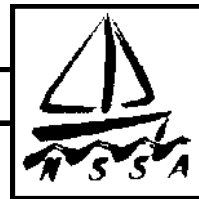

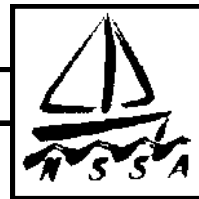

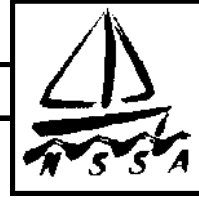
If you can spare some time I'd be grateful. It doesn't have to be all day.
